Editorial Policy: CJIL is committed to publishing timely and concise scholarly work. Manuscripts should be short and clear. CJIL prefers that manuscripts do not exceed the following lengths: articles, 10,500 words; essays, 3700 words; perspectives, 3200 words; and book reviews, 2800 words. We discourage superfluous and tedious citations; where a source can easily be discerned from the text, the source need not be cited. Finally, we edit articles very lightly.
