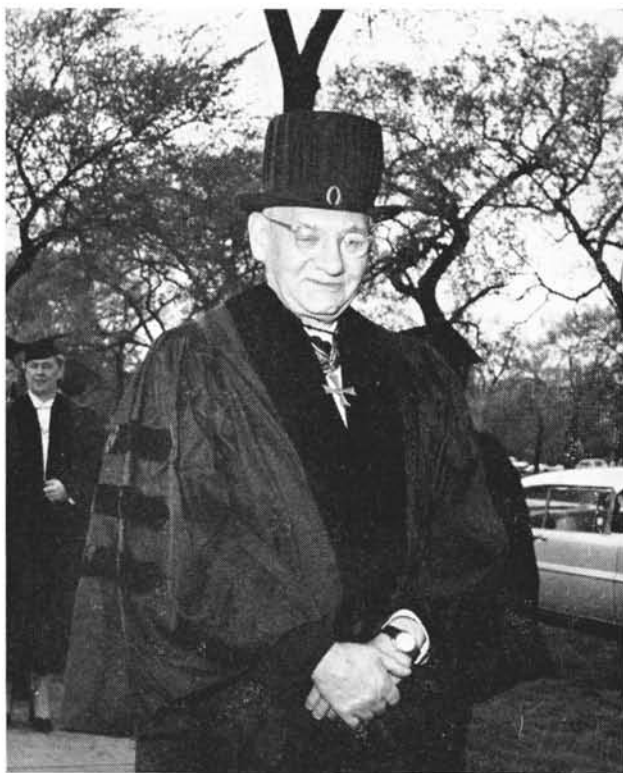


Faculty Notes

Professors Philip Kurland and Harry Kalven, Jr., have served, with Federal and state judges and practitioners, as members of the Illinois Supreme Court Committee on Jury Instructions. The Committee has developed a body of uniform instructions which will henceforth be required, by rule of the Supreme Court, of all Illinois trial courts.

Max Rheinstein, Max Pam Professor of Comparative Law, has been awarded the degree of Doctor Juris, *honoris causa*, by the University of Basel, on the occasion of the University's 500th anniversary. Professor Rheinstein recently received the honorary degree of Juris Doktor from the University of Stockholm.

It is with regret that we report the death of Arthur Kent, a member of the Law School Faculty from 1927-34. Mr. Kent taught at the University of Oregon and the University of Cincinnati before coming to Chicago. He left the Faculty to become Assistant Chief Counsel of the Internal Revenue Service, and later Assistant General Counsel of the Treasury.
