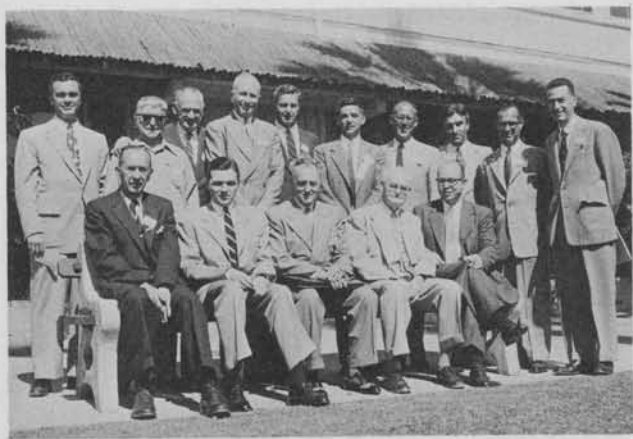


## *Moot Court Brief*
