

MEMORIAL FUNDS

Mr. John P. Wilson, Jr., a member of the Chicago Bar, and Mrs. Anna W. Dickinson are the donors of a trust fund of \$400,000 the purpose of which is to endow a chair of law to be entitled the John P. Wilson, Sr., Professorship of Law, as a memorial to their father, Mr. John P. Wilson, Sr., who was for many years an eminent member and leader of the Chicago Bar.

Mrs. Anna L. Raymond has created a trust fund of \$30,000, to be known as James Nelson Raymond Memorial Fund, as a memorial to her husband, James Nelson Raymond. The income from this fund is used for the purchase of needed books for the University of Chicago Law Library.
